GET THE LOOK

Create this look by keeping your investment pieces such as sofas and dining tables in the traditional style and add elements such as canvas prints and simple velvet or silk drapery panels designed with grommets hanging on simple stainless or wrought iron rods. Take a traditionally styled chair and upholster it with a very simple velvet fabric allowing the shape of the chair to gain prominence.
